The **Bob York Splash Park** may be added to a private pool rental from 8:15-10:15 p.m. for an additional \$125.00.

The **Bob York Splash Park** may be rented for private gatherings on **Saturday mornings** from 8:00-10:00 a.m. for \$150.00.
